

How you can help the school earn FREE Money

If we can get ½ of the 800 families in the parish to participate, at an average of \$300/month just in grocery scrip:

\$300 x 400 families x 12 months = \$1.440,000 worth of scrip sold per year, with %3 = \$43,200 for the school. This is just groceries!

The subscription is a regularly scheduled purchase like groceries, of a specific amount of particular scrip. For example, The Duchesneaus sign up for a subscription of \$50 Super Saver and \$50 HyVee scrip every week. A check comes in from the Duchesneaus for \$100, and their subscribed scrip either is sent home with one of the school kids, or reserved for pick-up after Mass on Saturday/Sunday.

A subscription would be a standard order of scrip that doesn't change often. This doesn't mean other scrip cannot be purchased through communication folder or before/after mass. Spontaneous purchases can still be made through those traditional methods.

The Duchesneaus also have a bill-pay service through their bank, so that they can issue a check to St. Teresa's Scrip program on an automatic basis. The check is mailed to a dependable address (i.e. the Rectory), and then entered into the scrip system as payment for their subscribed scrip. The memo line on the check issued can also reflect either the subscribed scrip (i.e. "\$50-SS + \$50 HV"), or a variance from the usual (i.e. "usual + \$50 Kohls").
